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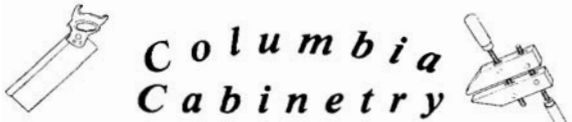

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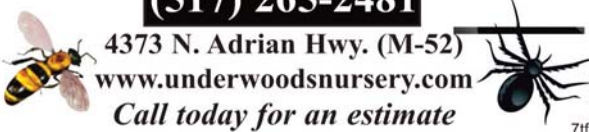
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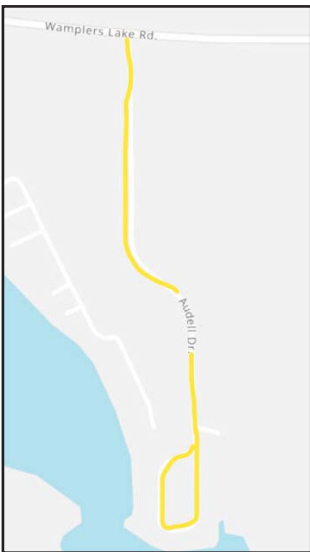

Request: Variance application to permit a 1,200-square foot pole barn in the northeast front yard. The pole barn will be constructed in the front yard area. The Columbia Charter Township Zoning Ordinance prohibits accessory structures in the front yard area, Article 20, Section 20.8.
