TAKE NOTICE that at a meeting on March 26, 2026, the Township of Rome adopted Ordinance No. 26-03-01, An Ordinance to Amend the Zoning Ordinance Regarding Special Land Uses (the "Ordinance"). The Ordinance is available for inspection at the Township's website, <http://www.rometownship.org>, or in person at the Township Hall, 9344 Forrister Road, Adrian, MI 49221, by appointment. Please contact the Township Clerk, Robin Robertson, at (517) 605-5163 to make an appointment. Copies may be obtained for a reasonable charge. The Ordinance takes effect upon the expiration of seven (7) days after the publication of this Notice and Summary. A summary of the Ordinance follows:

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 26-03-01

Section 1. Addition of New Section 11.94 to the Zoning Ordinance. This Section of the Ordinance authorizes the Township Board to adopt a temporary moratorium by resolution to pause land use reviews and approvals while reviewing or updating zoning regulations to protect public health, safety, or welfare. It also allows the Township Board to adopt a moratorium by resolution following a recommendation to do so by the Planning Commission. The resolution must include the purpose, supporting findings, a defined duration (up to 12 months with one possible 6-month extension), and be publicly noticed within 15 days of adoption.

Section 2. Validity and Severability. This Section of the Ordinance makes its provisions severable.

Section 3. Repealer. This Section of the Ordinance repeals any ordinances or parts of ordinances that conflict with the Ordinance to extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Section of the Ordinance states that the Ordinance takes effect upon the expiration of seven (7) days after its publication.

Proposed Patriot Estates Improvements: A project to install, improve, and maintain lighting systems within Grass Lake Charter Township, specifically within the Patriot Estates Subdivision, which can be summarized as a project to install and maintain lighting systems within the Patriot Estates Subdivision.

Proposed Special Assessment District: Properties within Patriot Estates Subdivision within Grass Lake Charter Township.

ORDINANCE FOR DATA CENTER MORATORIUM

The Township Board of Trustees of Leoni Township make the following findings:
 1. There is a state-wide zoning issue with data centers, to-wit: with the advent of artificial intelligence in computing, data centers are much more prolific than in the past.
 2. Zoning ordinances and Mast Plans, including those of Leoni Township, are not prepared for the proliferation of data centers.
 3. An urgent and/or emergent situation exists in Leoni Township concerning zoning of data centers.
 Therefore, the Township Board of Trustees of Leoni Township ordains the following ordinance:
 Sec 42-9
 A) Definition of Data Center: A building or campus of buildings, on one or more parcels aggregating 1 acre or more, primarily used to house computer servers, communications equipment, and technology infrastructure for the centralized storage, management, and dissemination of data. Includes associated backup power systems, cooling towers, and security facilities.
 B) Effective May 1, 2026, it shall be unlawful to operate a data center in the Township of Leoni.
 C) Unless the Township Board votes to sunset this moratorium prior to the first of any month, this moratorium will renew each and every month beginning on the first of each month.
 D) This moratorium will automatically sunset on May 1, 2027.
